In observance of **World Architecture Day**, and to celebrate our 10th/11th anniversary, you are cordially invited to celebrate with the **Alex Foundation** in our **Architecture-Bake!** In this bake-off, you would flex your culinary skills by baking, designing, and constructing an iconic building of your choice. Your best design talents would transfer from buildings to cakes. The rules of the bake-off are provided.

World Architecture Day is a global observance held annually on the first Monday of October "to reflect on the state of our towns and cities and the basic right of all to have adequate shelter. It is also intended to remind the world of its collective responsibility for the future of the human habitat." This initiative was created by the International Union of Architects in 1985.

Alex Foundation, a 501 (c) 3 nonprofit organization was established in 2010 to give limited access students opportunities to learn about architecture. The mission of the Alex Foundation is to engage students to consider careers and entrepreneurial opportunities in architecture, design, and the built environment. This mission is achieved through mentoring, strengthening students' capacity, and supporting their educational attainment.

ARCHITECTURE BAKE-OFF RULES

- 1. Teams may compete with no more than three (3) individuals on a team.
- 2. Cakes must be baked at home (not store bought).
- 3. Cakes must be designed, assembled, and constructed at the bake-off October 3rd.
- 4. All bake goods must be fully baked, complete and edible.
- 5. There is no limit to the height or width of the cakes design. Innovation is encouraged.
- 6. All cakes must be a design of an iconic building.
- 7. Cakes will be the only type of dessert that may be designed and built in the bake-off. Cupcakes, cake pops, bon bons, etc., are allowable as part of a design.
- 8. Award will be presented to one team only, NOT each individual.
- 9. Any leftover items will be the property of each team.
- 10. Arrive no later than 2:00 pm.

The Scoring System:

- 1. Cakes will be judged on a scale of 1-5, 5 being the highest.
- 2. Cakes will be judged on taste, texture, and design.
- 3. Judges will tally all the scores. The teams with the highest score will be the winner.
- 4. Only one place 1st place will be awarded.
